	Volunteers welcome patrons, ensure they are at the correct performance and theatre, prior to tearing tickets. Hosts also step on buses as greeters and provide instructions to visitors.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ushering
	Volunteers direct patrons to their seats, assist with wheelchairs, and provide safety for patrons who must exit the auditorium during the performance. Volunteers also serve as vendors by selling raffle tickets and ice cream, and performing other front-of-house duties as assigned.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Networking
	Volunteers help generate awareness of Drayton Entertainment through their respective social networks. This includes recruiting additional volunteers, passing along new sponsor/advertising leads, pursuing public speaking engagements for staff, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Marketing & Development
	Volunteers assist with Drayton Entertainment's marketing and development initiatives, including brochure distribution, community events and exhibitions, targeted mailings, archives, and other projects.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Housing & Accommodation
	Volunteers generate viable leads by leveraging relationships in the community with respective contacts in order to meet Drayton Entertainment's housing requirements for Company members each season.

	Volunteers assist in general clean-up prior to the season at each venue, with ongoing maintenance as needed throughout the season. This could include planting flowers, cleaning flower beds, sweeping sidewalks, picking up garbage and/or parking lot debris, etc.
